1. Sports Fiesta 2018

Date : 11 May 2018 (Friday)

Time : 7.25 am – 12.30 pm

Note: It is critical that all students report punctually at 7.25 am at the designated venue so as not to delay start time for each cohort at the various stations

Venue : Bedok Reservoir Park

Note: All students to report directly at the venue of their first event.

During the Sports Fiesta, students will participate in various activities which include Cross Country Run, Dragonboat Race, Telematch Relays and Fringe Games. While students are in the midst of competing in the various activities, they also get the opportunity to bond together as a class.
