## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q1. Is it compulsory for students to attend all CCA trial and audition sessions?**

Ans: No. Students just need to attend those CCA sessions that they are interested to know more about or have interest in joining. For individual CCA, students can attend any 1 session out of the scheduled sessions for the week. (For e.g. Badminton trial is scheduled on Tuesday and Thursday, student just need to attend 1 out of the 2 sessions).

**Q2. Can I still get selected by the CCA if I do not attend the trial and audition sessions?**

Ans: It depends. Especially for Sports CCA, where coaches will be there to assess their skills, it will be advisable for students interested to join Sports CCA to go for the trials.

**Q3. Do DSA students need to attend the CCA trials?**

Ans: No. They are already assigned the CCA from the DSA exercise.

**Q4. How can my son select their CCAs?**

Ans: There will be a CCA selection exercise from 16 Jan to 19 Jan through google form. Details on this exercise will be sent out to all parents through PG. Students will each have 4 choices. It is advisable for students to put in their 1<sup>st</sup> choice wisely. (For e.g. if students went for trials and did not get selected, they should not put that CCA as their 1<sup>st</sup> choice.)

**Q5. Do I need to prepare anything for the Sports Trials?**

Ans: Students must be in sports attire for all Sports Trials. For Football, students will need to be in full gear for safety reasons (i.e. PE attire, Long socks, Shine Guards and Gloves for keeper). For other Sports CCA, students can bring their own sports equipment if they have (for e.g. badminton rackets or floorball sticks). If not, there is no need to purchase as we have the necessary sports equipment for loan.
