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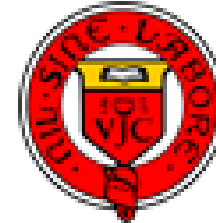

- Apply CJC Arts/Science as their **First Choice**;
or
- Apply CJC Arts and Science as their **First & Second Choices**



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Direct School Admission - JC

- **Who is it for?**

Students who are very sure they intend to study in JC, focusing on CONCEPTUAL Understanding and have talents or interests that the JC can offer to develop.

- **Why DSA?**

Students with talents and interests and willing to commit to a JC that offers a suitable talent development programme in their area of strength or interest.

Students should also consider the pace of learning and the overall range of programmes offered by the JC.



Important Dates for DSA-JC Applicants

- **Application Phase:**
 - Open as early 2 May 2018
 - Closes by end of Term 2
- **Selection Process** (Audition/Trials/Portfolio Review & Interview):
 - Mid-year holidays (*please be in Singapore!*)
- **Offer, Acceptance and Withdrawal Period (Whole Term 3):**
 - Phase 1 Offer: Week 1 to Week 4
 - Phase 1 Acceptance: Week 5
 - Phase 1 Cooling off: Week 6 (*Students to decide if they wish to take up offer in Phase 2*)
 - Phase 2 Offer: Week 6 to Week 8
 - Phase 2 Acceptance: Week 9
 - **Withdrawal: For both phases by Term 4 Week 4**

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Early Admission Exercise - Polytechnic

- **Who is it for?**

Students who are very sure they intend to pursue a Practice-based education and have talents or interests that is/are relevant to or recognised by the course.

- **Why EAE?**

EAE is an aptitude-based admissions exercise that allows students to apply for and receive conditional offers for admission to polytechnics prior to receiving their final grades. Students should also consider the style of learning and the overall range of programmes offered by the course.



Important Dates for EAE Applicants

- **Application Stage:**
 - *Last week of June Holidays*
- **Selection Stage (Audition/Trials/Portfolio Review & Interview):**
 - *Term 3 Week 2 to Week 7*
- **Offer, Acceptance and Withdrawal Stage:**
 - *Offer and Acceptance: Term 3 Week 9*
 - *Withdrawal: Term 3 Week 10 to Term 4 Week 4*
